

MIC-MARC Map - 2003-07-16

Goal of MIC-MARC Map - provide MARC export in CSV and XML for loading into WorldCat and RLG's web portal and for supporting Z39.50 searching using the Bib-1 and Bib-2 profiles for MARC

**Assumptions - native AACR2/MARC data will be maintained with indicators and subfields intact for round trip
Map is intended to support export and display in AACR2/MARC for non-MARC data**

only provide this map if the organization provided MARC data that is being round-tripped or if the organization feels their local ID is important to maintain in a MARC map
System Assigned. Unless MARC identification code is used by organization, there won't be a map
While 700 \$e provides a map, in the interests of simplicity, we recommend no map at this time.
Note did not map to 260 \$a; need more precise definition of MIC data element. If the data does not originate in MARC, no place of publication or publisher will be provided.
If duration is included in 300 \$a, then it is part of CarrierExtent and can't be distinguished as duration in MARC

Is there a fixed field that would be useful? Otherwise, since type is required for MPEG-7, we will explicitly assign the default of "audiovisual" to accommodate MPEG-7 mapping

Although some organizations, like LC, put copy type in 300 \$c or \$3, this is unpredictable. Use Copy type only for fields that explicitly map in a machine-recognizable way to copy type. Follow carrier types with copy type in display records. This way, whether organizations include copy type in carrier type fields or provide separate fields for this information, the information will be concatenated appropriately for display

Maps well only if roundtripping from MARC to MARC. Most nonMARC data elements will not be able to be formatted appropriately for AACR2/MARC

For MARC to MARC, use 300 \$b

What are the issues for supplying the print constant information required for formatting?

If constructing 008, map also to 008 bytes 35-37
Could also map to 562 \$c; prevailing practice unknown
